Here are examples of the important programs that your support will benefit:

- Our seasonal education and action campaigns have reached over 26,000 people since 2012, with participants registering over **52,000 actions** to save water, conserve energy, grow food, reduce waste and build community!
- Our online programs **Green Sofa Cinema** and **Sustainability LIVE** are free broadcasts where special guests share their knowledge and provide the inspiration, education, and camaraderie that will help us all live more resilient lives. We're also re-introducing our popular **Sustainable Living Workshop** series, teaching skills for sustainable living, such as composting and drip irrigation.
- Our work with the **Cleaner Contra Costa Challenge** in partnership with the County and other local agencies helps to advance community goals for health, safety, economic vitality, energy independence, and quality of life. This is a valuable online platform for people to measure their household footprint, find local resources and rebates to reduce carbon emissions, and save money. Over 2400 households are currently participating. Together, they've saved over 290,000 dollars, 1,500,000 gallons of water and reduced over 730 tons of greenhouse gas emissions!
- Our **Sustainable Leaders in Action Team** is an amazing group of 20 young leaders who are finding innovative ways to engage and mentor students in fun, meaningful activities that develop their leadership skills, promote awareness and encourage action.
